Purpose

Wearing the school uniform demonstrates a sense of pride for the school and our local community. The uniform promotes easy recognition and student safety. Students who are inappropriately dressed may be required to change into clothing provided by the school. In some cases, parents/carers will be contacted. Shirts

- School uniform tops with the Aunty Agnes Shea High School Logo. These can be purchased from Working Gear.
- No singlet-type garments or those that expose the midriff are permitted.
- Students are permitted to wear pain-coloured under garments.

Jumpers/Jackets

- School Hoodies with the Aunty Agnes Shea High School logo.

Pants/Shorts/Skirts

- Students may wear **plain black** pants, trackpants, shorts, leggings, or skirts.
- Shorts/skirts need to be an appropriate length (mid-thigh or longer, measured by arms at sides, shorts must extend below fingertips).

Footwear

- Sports shoes (Runners/Joggers) or black leather shoes.
- Enclosed shoes are a safety requirement for multiple subject areas.
- **Thongs, Crocs or backless shoes are not acceptable.**

Caps/Hats

- Caps and hats are encouraged for sun protection outside.
